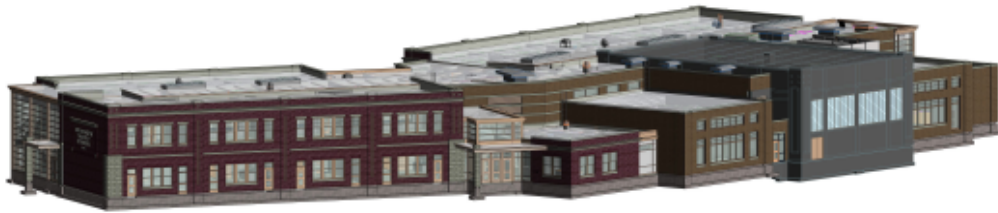

Meet inside the CSM jobsite trailer. There is parking on the street or you can pull into the jobsite.

John Kakoczki with CSM will lead the tour and provide an overview of the project.

This project includes demolishing the existing school building at 1919 Portage St. and replacing it with new 68,000 sq. ft. two-story elementary school building. The existing gymnasium will be salvaged and incorporated into the new building layout. The new two-story building will consist of classrooms, workrooms, office areas, media center, cafeteria, kitchen, boiler and mechanical rooms. The building will consist of slab-on-grade for 1st floor, precast concrete floor for 2nd floor, and steel joist and metal decking for roof. Sitework will include digging up a buried building under the existing playground area and complete site improvements over the entire site. The architect for this project is Tower Pinkster.
