



## NAWIC "LEGO" BLOCK KIDS 2019 PROGRAM SPONSORSHIP & VOLUNTEER REQUEST – DEADLINE JANUARY 14th, 2019

The 2018 National Association of Women in Construction Chapter 302's "Block Kids" program will be held on **Saturday**, **January 26**, **2019**, **8 am to 12 noon**, at the Plainwell Middle School Cafeteria. The Block Kids Building Program is a national building competition supported by the NAWIC Education Foundation. The program is non-discriminatory and is open to all students in **Kindergarten through sixth grade**. Each student is provided with 100 "Lego" type building blocks and the option to choose three other items (rock, string, aluminum foil, or poster board) to incorporate into their project. Each student is given one hour to build a structure of his or her choice. People, plants, and animals are not allowed. Judges from the construction and engineering industry view each student's project and discuss with them what they have constructed. Evaluations are recorded on a point system and then turned over to our record keepers who tally the points. All judges are local volunteers from companies within the construction community.

All students will receive a t-shirt donated by sponsorships from local companies. NAWIC is **requesting sponsorships of \$100** to provide the t-shirts to all of the student participants and to assist in covering the fees of the program since it is free to all participants. **Sponsor names will be on the back of the t-shirts and each sponsor will receive a free t-shirt if desired. Check, credit card, or PayPal payments are accepted please follow instructions below to sponsor the event.** We anticipate up to 100 students from local school districts will participate.

We are in need of 40 judges and/or volunteers, please complete the form below or register on our website if you would like to judge or volunteer at the event. If you have not participated previously the event is an awesome experience and we are typically completed by noon on Saturday.
